3. Staffing updates

- a. Reorganization of staff: Welcome Stephanie, joins Cathi in office (tentatively to be known as Recreation & Sports Coordinator and Facility & Facility Events Coordinator)
- b. Dan is now full-time
- c. Have 3 part time FC attendants (Welcome Fred, Kacey & Samantha)
- d. Working with DPW (Bill & Scott) on FC maintenance issues, aka the DOOR, boiler, etc.

4. Arena & Facility Update

- a. Salt hopper is HUGE help
- b. Gonna need some new equipment this year:
 - i. Drag for fields (Scott M helping us to look for a grant)
 - ii. Gator (possible grant?) for maintaining pond path
 - iii. Better truck for plowing
 - iv. Improve pond path (attract birds, label flora, plant native species? Rails near edge?) It's .475 mile
 - v. Currently have 3 phones (2 #s), need cordless set up for one in kitchen/concessions, FC and office cubby
 - vi. Need better computers and some software
 - vii. Need e-payment system: suggestions, experiences?
 - viii. Still researching possibilities of laser tag, but on hold until we resolve other facility issues and have a better handle on the budget (grant suggestions welcome)
- c. Plan to start using rental ice contracts for all ice rentals, similar to the conference room rental contracts/reservation forms. Mirrors conference room rental with specific ice information included.
- d. Plan to ask all skaters and walkers to sign a waiver of liability every year (just once per year) to cover any liability issues. Same as Fitness Center and aerobics waiver.
- e. Hockey tournament season is over but we still have 3-4 more ice rentals for scrimmages.
- f. Ice rental rates have not changed in price for over a decade. Conference room rental increased by 50% (\$300) to \$450 from last year to this year. A suggested 50% increase for ice rental would be:

- h. Heating and boilers: heat working (too hot sometimes). Dan from Automated Climate Control:
 - To complete the repairs on boiler No 1 (replace the gas valve and replace the seal shaft on the pump) \$1855.00
 - To complete repairs on the system pump (new bearing assembly and shaft seal) the total cost is \$2262.50
 - Currently boiler No 2 is working and heating the place.
 - You will need to fix both but if you do 1 now and 1 later then spend the \$2262.50 now.
